Our school teachers had a special treat when our sister school, HCA (Harvest Christian Academy) on Guam sent one of their principles along with a master teacher to do our teacher training last month. One of our teachers made this comment at the closing banquet: *"You do not know how much we have learned from all the sessions, it's worth a three-year college education!!!"* The Lord also worked out a unique situation for us this month.
