Dear Pastor and church,

In a great display of love and trust, Job, after learning of the loss of his seven sons and three daughters, as well as the loss of his servants and livestock, prostrated himself in the presence of our holy God and worshiped. Job could worship in spite of the dreadful circumstances because he recognized that God is sovereign and because he loved God above all else. God is good.

This was the theme of my Dad's funeral service. Dad passed away on July 18 at 9:45 in the evening. Kathy and I had started on our 35th wedding anniversary trip, but were called back after a few days. We drove fourteen hours straight and arrived at the hospital just before midnight on the 17th, and just in time to visit with him for a matter of minutes before he slumped into a state of unconsciousness. I think that he was waiting for us to arrive before he finally gave up. He died the next day. Also, we were shocked to learn of the death of one of Dad's nephews, a first cousin and friend of mine. This man was only 55 years old, and he lived just seven miles from where Dad had lived all his life before coming to Maine so that we could care for him. My son, Bobby, and I had Dad's funeral in Athens, Pennsylvania, on the 24th, and I had my cousin's funeral in the same funeral home on the 25th. Our family heard two Bible messages, and they were challenged to turn from sin and trust Christ. Please pray that we will see precious souls of family members saved in the future.

We are planning to start another church after the first of the year. Also, we still need a larger place to meet here in Brunswick, and we would like to purchase property for building in the future. Please be praying with us about these things.

Thank you for your prayers and support. It means more to us than I could possibly express. May the Lord bless you.
