Dear Friends,

As you know, we have been meeting for three months now at the Hamlin Elementary School in South Portland, Maine. It has really been a slow start for us compared to the last two churches which we planted. We only have five people from the area who attend somewhat faithfully; however, they along with our co-workers, Tom and Amy Bromwell, and a family provided each week by the Mid-Coast Baptist Church in Brunswick, make for a small crowd and good services.

Please pray that the Lord will bless us with first-time visitors on a regular basis. We plan to distribute another 5,000 *John and Romans* booklets and invitations to homes in the area beginning in April. We are praying that the Lord will give us a few families as a result of this second effort. We are also just beginning to do some advertising. Would you pray with us that the advertising would be effective in reaching people who will attend our services?

We are working at getting the Mid-Coast Baptist Church into a building of their own. We have entered into a contract to purchase a piece of land in Brunswick. There are contingencies in place which make it possible for the church to back out of the deal if certain problems would arise which would keep us from using this particular property, but right now it looks good. The land is already zoned for religious use, and we recently received a report which indicates that the soils test was positive for a subsurface wastewater disposal system. Now we are working with the surveyor and hope to present the project to the town of Brunswick sometime in March or April. Please pray that God will lead and bless in this project.
