We are really on the run here in Maine. Planting the church in South Portland, building the church building in Brunswick, holding two mid-week services, etc. A retired pastor friend told me that the things that I am doing are to be done by those who are forty years old, not those who are sixty years old. Now and then when I get tired and worn down and lie in bed unable to sleep, I get to thinking that he makes a good point!

The truth is that I thank God for every bit of what we are involved in. It is exciting beyond belief to be involved in the work of God and to experience His blessings day by day.

Much of the site work has been completed on the property in Brunswick. The footers, foundation walls, and the slab have been poured, and this week we will begin framing. The men and their wives with Cornerstone Baptist Church Builders arrived about ten days ago. They will be working with us until the project is completed sometime this fall. We could use more help; if you live within driving distance please plan to come and help us on Saturdays. If you live farther away and are willing to come at your own expense, we would be delighted to have you here. Also, I figure that we will need \$70,000 to \$80,000 more than we have raised and borrowed to finish the project. If you are willing to help, please send a check made out to Mid-Coast Baptist Church. This young church has given "beyond their power," and they continue to do so.

In closing, please pray for Carlos and Tommy. Both of these men were saved and attend the South Portland church. Carlos moved to Texas for work, but after a few months he moved back to South Portland so that he could be in our church. He realized that he had made a mistake in moving away. Both he and Tommy appear to be growing "in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ."
