

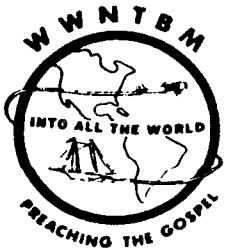

Our Dear Hardy:

What a joy to say that another soul has been saved. God's family has been enlarged. Praised be His Holy Name! The new name added into the Book of the Lamb is Alejandro.

Pray for Alejandro: Just last month a young man from Mexico was visiting our church, and after the preaching he was willing to accept the Lord Jesus as his personal Savior. He attended a Baptist church many years ago with his mother. She is the only one who is saved in the family. Could you imagine the joy of that mother many miles from here when she knew that her younger son was saved in Spain? Now he needs your prayers to grow in the Lord.

Pray also for this situation: I would like to ask you for your prayers on the following subject. The pastor we are helping has told me seven times that he has never been called to be a pastor. Since we arrived, he is telling me the same over and over. Just recently he has said that he is going to resign as pastor. He asked me to take over the church. We are praying to seek God's will for us in this matter. The deadline for which I have told him to wait is the beginning of next month. Please, pray for us on this difficult situation, and tell us any advice you may have for us. We would appreciate it very, very much, dear people. On Sunday mornings for Sunday School (we do not have Morning Service, only S.S.), it's about 9-12 of us counting the pastor and his family. The relationship and fellowship between us is just wonderful which assures us that it is nothing personal. Till this moment, I have always encouraged him to stay as pastor. But although I hoped he would continue, he is now determined. This is a very important thing to remember.

Pray for our new converts: This past year three people have been saved. They are: **Luisa**, she is a young lady with some troubles at her home. Her mother has forbidden her to attend church; even so, she comes once in a while. A young lady of our church is discipling her. Then, **Chema**, he is very faithful attending church. He is growing fast and is a joy for the whole church. He was an alcoholic, and the Lord has done a wonderful change in his life. Another saved is Chema's friend, named **Angel**. We wonder about his salvation. He has been involved with alcohol as well, but he is not faithful. Finally, **Alejandro**, our last convert. He will be with us till maybe this next summer when he is going back to Mexico. We hope he is going to be a good missionary to his own family. He is very faithful as well.

Pray also for Nelly: She is suffering from *fibromialgia*, and also she has four by-passes in her heart with the result that one of them is not working at all. She feels always very tired and ill. She hardly comes to church. Her husband is a very faithful man.

Concerning our family, we are now all right. We have all been sick but Samuel. I have been in bed for almost a week, then my wife, and finally Damaris, our daughter. She is now with us till she gets married on August 3. Pray also for all the wedding plans.

Dear people, thank you very much for your faithful prayers and support. We are here because God wants us to be here, and you are helping us to fulfill His will.
