Ministry

Since our last letter we have started our Bible Institute and have 15 students. Ten students are from other villages and they meet together at another church around a cassette player and listen to the class through the cassette. The other five students are from our church here in Aiyinasi. We record the classes and send them on market days to the Sendu Baptist Church. The men are thrilled about the opportunity to learn more about the Bible. They are taking 8 classes - Hermeneutics, Biblical Missions, Song Leading, Growing in Grace, Analysis I John, English 1 and Old Testament Survey. This is just a start to see whether the men are able to receive all of it. They have their first four tests on Thursday, September 23. Please pray for me that the Lord will speak through me that I will give the men what they stand in need of.

The church here at Aiyinasi is doing well. On Sunday we had 47 in attendance. We are looking forward to what the Lord has for us during this time. The country here is getting ready for elections. As you pray for the elections in America pray for the elections here in Ghana as well. The president they have now has been the best president they have ever had. We would like to see him become president again.
