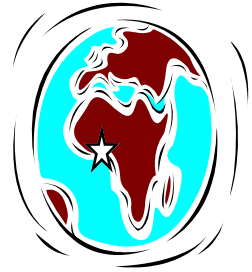


The Walker Family to Ghana, West Africa

Ministry

We have been blessed by some new converts here in the past few weeks. One that comes to mind is an older lady in her 70-80's. She accepted Christ about three weeks ago, and she has been on fire for the Lord. One Sunday morning we sent a van to pick some of the people from the next village (approx. 3 miles). Well, this particular Sunday she missed the van and still made it to church in time. She apologized for missing the van, but I told her that we were sorry for missing her. She told me that she did not want to miss a single church service. She asked me if we had church every night. I told her no, we have Sunday morning and evening and Wednesday night prayer meeting. She asked if she could come in the evening also. I told her it would be great. Well since that time she has come faithfully for every church service. She is always waiting for me right by the road. She has invited her children and grandchildren to come. Although the children and grandchildren have not come yet they say that they are planning to come. Last Wednesday night we have a wonderful church service. I was preaching a message about how God overloads us with blessings, and when we fall we confess and he forgives and cleanses us. I used the illustration about a cup of water and a big bucket. We represent the cup, while God represents the bucket (a crude but effective illustration). We showed how that sometimes we are dirty and God cleans us. When we do the will of the Lord he blesses or fills our cup with blessings. As I used the bucket with water I began to fill the cup with water. Well, before long the blessings were overflowing and the people were shouting and praising God.
