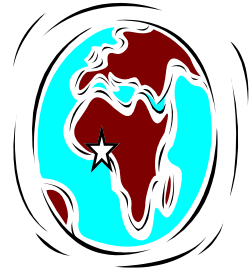


# The Walker Family to Ghana, West Africa

Esther was loved by all who knew her. She will always be remembered here in Africa as well as America. We know that all things work together for good. There is nothing that we want more than to make our Lord and Saviour happy and to hear him say "Well done thou Good and **Faithful** servant".

Sometimes it is very difficult to look around while having family devotions and not seeing a little face smiling at you, or when you go through your daily activities and she is not there to help you like she normally did. We know that she is better off where she is now. Esther is no longer suffering anymore. **PRAISE THE LORD!** She has seen her grandfather whom she had never seen before, but most of all she sees JESUS. At the closing of her life, my wife was telling Esther to come back to mommy. Since her voice was gone from coughing to much, she shook her head "no". Then my wife told her to come back to play with your brothers, she shook her head "no". My wife then asked her, "Are you going to see Jesus?" and with a smile on her face she shook her head "yes," and then she was with Him. Even now I still wonder what Esther saw on the other side. He is the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords, the Alpha and Omega. Micah 7:18 says, "Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy". Nobody has mercy like he does. It is new everyday.
