We have started our Teens for Christ classes, and have 30 teens every Thursday evening coming to this class. Some have already accepted Christ as their personal Saviour. Praise the Lord! We have also started Bible Quiz Teams with the teens and adults. They have to memorize Bible verses and answer questions concerning the messages that I preach. This does two things: 1) They have to memorize the Word of God; and 2) They have to listen to the preaching of the Word of God to get the answers. They have done exceptionally well. One young girl in particular has exceeded all that I could expect. Her name is Angelina. If there are verses to memorize Angelina has them ready whenever I call on her to quote them. Angelina was saved during our children's crusade back in March. What a blessing to see her so faithful to the Word of God. Please pray for Angelina to continue for the Lord. She is only 13 years old and doing so much for the cause of Christ. She invites her friends to church, and has not missed a service since she was saved back in March.

**Family:** Our family is doing well. We are still trying to adapt to the absence of Esther. It still brings tears to my eyes as I remember her and her unique ways. God's grace is still sufficient though. Please continue to pray for Rebecca for it has been hard for her as well. Ronnie and Daniel are back to school again and both are doing well academically. She reminds my wife and I of my sister Tonya at that age. She still has her blonde hair and brown eyes and is always smiling. I do not think she has a serious bone in her body. She laughs about everything. She also likes to sing and she will tell you to sing as well. My wife is doing as well as can be expected. She is a wife, mother, school teacher, Sunday school teacher, piano player, member of the Bible quiz team, teacher for the Children's Bible class on Saturday, and is beginning to teach English to the Ladies class. Please pray that the Lord will send forth more laborers to help in these ministries. My wife has started training a lady in one of our churches to teach. She is a Godly lady who is very humble and willing to help. She is a tremendous blessing, as she has a heart for the children as well. Her name is Cecilia. Please pray that she will continue to learn and will be a great asset to the ministry. Thank you for all you have done for me and my family. We are truly grateful.
