Dear fellow believers,

We are blessed of the Lord, everyday we are blessed. A few weeks ago we had our second Bible Conference here in Ghana. We were thrilled to see how God worked in the lives of the people. My Pastor from the Orangeburg Baptist Tabernacle in Orangeburg, S.C., came and preached during the conference along with some local preachers and missionaries. We were able to see 5 souls come to Christ during that conference, and were able to see some make commitments to serve God more. The preaching was exactly what we needed.

Just last Sunday we had 6 come to Christ, 5 men and 1 lady. We have been praying for this lady for a long time and we were able to see her with tear filled eyes bow her head and accept Christ as her Lord and Saviour. Praise the Lord!! Please pray that we will be able to reach her husband and the relatives of the others that came to Christ. The Lord is so good to us. Last Sunday we had 115 people in service. What a blessing!!!

We have been busy with the radio broadcast and our Christian Day School. We are turning down students everyday because of finances and faculty. We are going to start an ACE school when we return from our furlough. Please pray that we will raise the money we need to reach these other children with education and more importantly the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Ronnie and Daniel are growing fast and learning the local language and French as well. Much better than their father. We are trying the best we can. The Lord has truly blessed my wife with gift of teaching. I was watching her teach the other day and watching the children respond - it was just something to see. The people see something different in the way we teach and how we teach, which is why we have such an interest by the people. We want to reach these children as well as their parents. Having a school for the people just might be the way to open a door for us to speak to them.

Please pray for our need of generator, as the one we were using has given up the ghost. We are able to purchase a diesel one in Accra for \$2,000 - \$5,000 depending on the watts. The electricity has been going off because of a water shortage in the dam. We are having electricity for 36 hours and then off for 12 hours at a time. It becomes trouble when your meats and items become destroyed because of no electricity. Please pray that we may be able to purchase a generator. Thank you for all you have for us.
