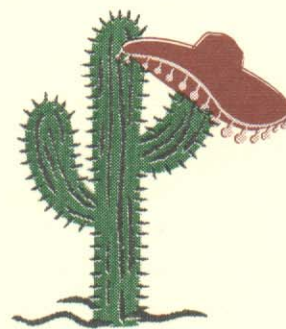

### Family

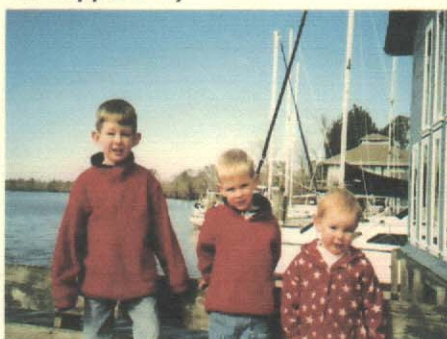
